Job Description

Camp Family

Reports to: Camp Family Coordinators (2)

General Description of Duties:

Under the direction of the Camp Family Coordinators, work as a member of a team assigned to assist in cleaning and maintaining the site, and in preparing food and cleaning the kitchen. May also have occasional assignments in Program or assisting Conferences.

Principle Duties:

- Clean restrooms and buildings
- Assist in kitchen, preparing food, unloading food orders & doing laundry
- Wash dishes and pots, clean kitchen & dish room
- Assist Environmental Task Force (ETF) staff in repairs and maintenance of site
- Assist in staffing and operating camp store
- Assist Waterfront Staff with manning the Buddy Board
- Assist Program staff
- Assist Support Services Staff
- Attend training about chemicals, blood borne pathogens, emergency procedures, camper safety, and other pertinent topics
- Attend daily Camp Family meetings and weekly full-staff meetings
- Other duties as assigned.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Must be at least 16 years old by June 15th

The successful candidate will be able to:

- Lift and carry at least 30 lb., unassisted
- Read and understand instructions on cleaning product labels
- Follow written or verbal directions
- Be open to feedback and assistance
- Work in ways that reduce waste and protect God's Creation
- Work in a team setting
- Live in a close community setting with shared bedroom and restroom (divided by gender)
- Live in, work in, and encourage a Christian community.
