



Silver Lake Day Visit Safety Guidelines

During COVID-19

- Every guest (including children and youth) MUST complete a Contact Information Form before arriving at Silver Lake:

- Everyone needs to bring a mask.
 - Wear it any time you are within 15 feet of people from outside your group.
 - Wear your mask when arriving at camp for check-in process
- All guests must stop by the Health and Welcome Center upon arrival.
 - Please remain in your car. Silver Lake staff will come to your car.
 - It is okay to beep your horn to let us know you have arrived.
 - All guests will have their temperature taken.
 - All guest temperatures will be logged in the logbook.
 - If anyone in your party has as a fever (temperature of 100.4 or greater) you will not be able to visit site.
- Do NOT enter or attempt to enter any buildings other than the designated guest restroom. The designated restroom will be identified during check in.
 - Please practice good hygiene while on site.
- Please do NOT enter specialized areas: high ropes course, low ropes course, swimming waterfront, boating waterfront, and the garden.
- Only visit site with your household (family or roommates)
- Please bring all that you will need to enjoy Silver Lake.
 - Basketballs, Frisbees, Soccer balls, other sports equipment, lawn games, lawn chairs, hand sanitizer, food and drinks, etc. Picnic tables will NOT be provided.
 - Trash cans will be available near the basketball court and rocks by the Social Hall.
 - Disc Golf baskets and basketball hoops are available for use.
 - Please no camp fires or camp stoves while visiting
- In the event of an emergency: Emergency phones are located at the waterfront and at the summer office. Ask staff at check if you need more information.
 - In the event of Severe Weather: Please shelter in your car if possible. If not safely accessible, then the porch of Hillside & Circles Cabins or the Camp Family Cabin may be used in an emergency.
